Southeast CUNA Management School (SRCUS)

The 2013 session of the **Southeast CUNA Management School** will be held at the Georgia Center at the University of Georgia's Conference Center scheduled for June 7-14, 2013 in Athens, GA. We are accepting applications for scholarships for 2013. This school, since 1971, has equipped graduates with the skills and knowledge to meet the leadership challenges that arise in the credit union industry.

The procedure for awarding scholarships is designed to provide assistance to the most worthy student. A "*Points Guideline*" is used to determine if applicants are to be awarded scholarships. The system awards points for each applicant's contributions to the credit union movement and years in the credit union movement; preference is shown to individuals in management and/or professional marketing positions. Need - based on key credit union financial ratios - is also a factor for selecting the scholarship recipients.

Credit union employees wishing to apply for the scholarships should complete the attached application with requested support information and return to me by **April 15, 2013**. Scholarship recipients will be notified by **April 30, 2013**.

Anyone wishing to register for the schools should forward the appropriate fees to the school to ensure a slot. Please make room reservations early with the conference hotels. Room reservations and expenses are the responsibility of each student/credit union.

Scholarship applications must include a copy of the credit union's year-end financial statement and a letter of recommendation from your credit union supervisor or official.
